

Guest Play Guidelines and Recommendations

- Please enter through the main gate. Security will direct you to the Bag Drop.
- **A pass for entrance through the Longview gatehouse is required and will be sent to your cell phone prior to arrival.**
- All players should stop at the Bag Drop to unload their clubs and proceed to the parking lot.
- Please change clothing in the locker room located in the main clubhouse.
- The practice facility at the Clubhouse may be used for warm-up prior to play.
- Check in with the golf shop, located in the Golf House to the right of the practice green, upon arrival. Staff will direct you to the first tee when it is your time.
- **Longview is a no tee time facility Tuesday-Thursday. During these times your tee time is an approximation, and we will get your group to the tee as close as possible to that time depending on the level of play.**
- Golf fees, merchandise, and all F&B may be charged to a membership account, a reciprocal club account, or paid by credit card.
- A few of the Longview Golden Rules are:
 - Play fast- Swift pace of play is a priority. Our club's expectation for eighteen holes is four hours or less. Always allow faster players to play through. **Any group falling 15 minutes behind pace will be required to skip a hole.** Respectful pace of play ensures everyone's enjoyment of their round.
 - Please properly repair all ballmarks, sand divots, and rake bunkers.
 - Treat fellow golfers and staff with the utmost respect.
 - Leave the golf course better than you found it.
- Food & Beverage is available in the main grill, turnhouse, and from the beverage cart.
- Our dress code prohibits jeans, exercise apparel, and cargo shorts/pants. Ladies may wear skirts/shorts of appropriate length. Caps must always be worn with the bill forward and removed inside the clubhouse. Men's shirts must have a collar and always tucked in on property.
- Golfers must use the bathrooms provided on holes #2, #6, #15.
- Guests are restricted from recording any videos or taking pictures for use on social media without consent from The Club at Longview management.
- Cell phones may be utilized on property but must be always kept on silent mode.
- Failure to adhere to all club policies may result in removal from the golf course. Complaints from members or homeowners may also warrant removal.
